



Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
For
Collaboration between
Agape Youth Movement (AYM) NPC and Junior Chamber International (JCI)
Tshwane NPO

This MOU is entered into by and between JCI Tshwane and AYM, both headquartered in Pretoria, South Africa.

WHEREAS, JCI is a nonprofit organization of young active citizens age 18 to 40 years whose purpose is providing development opportunities that empower young people to create positive change around the world, uniting all sectors of society to create sustainable impact.

WHEREAS, Agape is an award-winning and innovative youth-led organization in South Africa, with a vision for a capacitated and empowered youth, who contribute towards the transformation of Africa. Agape also focuses on Youth and Learner Leadership Development.

Purpose

The purpose of this collaboration is to create opportunities for the development of young people, enabling them to work towards creating sustainable impact in communities across the world.

Areas of Collaboration

1. Organisational awareness

- 1.1 JCI Tshwane and AYM will endeavour to inform its membership and stakeholders about either organisation to foster an environment where its stakeholders and companies support and cooperate with both organisations.
- 1.2 JCI Tshwane will endeavour to inform its members of the value and importance of AYM to society, and will encourage and support JCI Tshwane members to participate in AYM activities.
- 1.3 JCI Tshwane will explore any joint projects with AYM.
- 1.4 Both organisations will include either organisation's name or information in their publications, website and hand outs.

2. Youth Entrepreneurship Programmes

- 2.1 Both organisations should regularly exchange information and materials with each other, on their respective programmes of action, training, publications, as well as the calendar of the meetings of their Commissions and Committees.
- 2.2 To the extent where one of the organisations plans for round tables or seminars that might be of interest for the other party, the organiser will inform the other party in due time, it being understood that the latter will strive at publicising the project.
- 2.3 AYM will assist JCI Tshwane with strategic resources such as mentor recommendation for JCI Tshwane's Youth Employment Project.

3. Events

- 3.1 Both organisations should invite each other to send representatives to their meetings, conferences, and events of high importance such as the Top Outstanding Young Person's Awards.
- 3.2 Wherever suitable, both parties may be contacted to help find suitable speakers/facilitators for their events.
- 3.3 AYM will assist JCI Tshwane to make use of Agape's allocated venue for JCI Tshwane's events.

Mutual Understanding

It is mutually agreed and understood by the parties that:

- A. This MOU is an agreement of mutual collaboration, and not an enforcement contract of law. It may not be enforced against the other party by any legal of equitable suit or action.
- B. This MOU attracts no financial or fiscal obligations. Any financial transactions that arise between the parties shall be on terms agreed by the parties and in accordance with any applicable laws, regulations and procedures.
- C. Either party may withdraw from agreement upon the written notification to the other party which notice shall become effective upon receipt

Duration


The duration of this MOU shall be for a three-year period (2017-2019), renewed by tacit agreement by the parties.

Amendments


This MOU may be waived, modified or amended by joint agreement of both parties.
